A YouthZone Program

Family and Community Engagement Teams (FACET) help at-risk youth in our communities by assessing the strength and needs of the youth and their family in order to create a comprehensive and individualized service plan to help ensure healthy development.

With FACET, families are provided with free resources, in one place, and thorough follow-up case management.

Who can FACET help?

Youth served by FACET must live in Eagle or Pitkin counties and have needs that go beyond the scope of their family's resources or needs the resources of more than one agency.

Both the young person and their family must be willing to actively participate in FACET.



Youth between the ages of 6 and 18 who are experiencing or are at risk of one or more of the following:

- School suspension, expulsion or academic failure
- Physical/behavioral/mental/emotional health issues
- Substance abuse
- Runaway
- Homelessness
- Delinquent behavior (involvement in the legal system)
- Teen pregnancy
- Serious parent/child conflict
